

Isaiah
Chapter 5

v. 25-- When we gave ourselves to Our Lord, we were crucified and resurrected with Him. Our former selves were killed and we were resurrected into a new life in Him. Each day, each minute, of our lives, we are to continue to keep our former selves crucified --brutally killed--and only live in and through Jesus Christ. This is what Jesus meant when He said "take up your cross and follow me". We must carry the cross with us at all times--not as a burden, but as a joy, to continually crucify our former selves and live His life!

v. 26-- His ensign is Jesus, and all who are open will come swiftly when He calls.

v. 27-- He is our protector--in every detail of our lives!!

v. 28-- Our arrows are sharp. They are the revelations for our lives from Jesus. Our bows should be bent and ready to fight Satan with the revelations whenever he strikes. We should be swift to go to Jesus with everything in our lives--external and internal. The things of the world and the things of the heart--and get our weapons to fight!

v. 29-- We are strong as lions, and should be as brave, because we have the POWER OF GOD IN US!!

v. 30-- Non believers will come against us like the sea roaring onto the land, and when they look on us, they don't see the light we have within us, because they are in darkness.

Chapter 6

v. 1-2-- The representation of the seraphims is this: the two wings they covered their eyes with means that The Lord forgives His peoples' sins of the mind and emotion. The two wings covering the feet represents His forgiving our sins of deeds and works.

v. 3-4-- The "posts of the door moved at the voice of Him". He is our door to eternal life. When we praise Him, as the angel was doing, doors open for us, too. He dwells in the praises of His people, and we should dwell in everlasting praise of Him!!

v. 5-7-- The Lord anoints us the same way He anointed Isaiah. We are His prophets when we're Baptized in the Holy Spirit--we know the things of God and though we are of unclean lips, we have been purged in the Spirit by Jesus.
