

Isaiah
Chapter 10

v. 33-34-- The Lord will lop off Satan's illusion power over all people eventually, but He chooses to use His people. We are the iron He will use to cut him down. (See Jeremiah 50:20-35 - Babylon is Satan----Also Jeremiah 51:12)

Chapter 11

v. 1-5-- Notice it says Jesus "shall not judge after the sight of his eyes..." So the Lord wants us to be in following Him---To live by faith, and not by what we see, hear and feel.

v. 6-9-- This is how the world is in reality since Calvary, what we see with our eyes, are the illusions of Satan, lying about his defeat. Our spirits are capable of seeing the reality, but our eyes and ears aren't. Once we all come together in perfection and unity of the Body of Christ, we will dissolve the illusions and all will see the reality. That is what it will be in the Millennium, but the reality is now!!!

v. 10-- This again is referring to Jesus--and Oh! How glorious His rest is!!!

v. 11-- In this time the Lord is setting His hand to recover more of His people from Satan's direct grips, and from worldliness, denominational differences, traditional darkness, and all the "isms" that Satan has planted to separate us from God's true love.

v. 12-13-- Again, He speaks of drawing His people together. Unless we unite in His name, our power cannot be complete.

v. 14-- When we unite as He intended, His Body can be completely powerful against the forces of Satan all over the world!

v. 15-16-- We will communicate and travel as though the seas and distance were no barrier. God's people are all over the earth, but we are united through Him, in intercessory prayer, and the communication of the Spirit.
