

Isaiah  
Chapter 52

v. 6-- When we do turn to Him, we know it is He who saved us!!

v. 7-- We can all spread His Word of Love--we need not leave home --we need not be in a large ministry. Each of us has a little ministry of our own. We minister to our families, friends, neighbors. We need not always even say anything. Just show the Love of Jesus to others, and they will see Jesus in us. They may not even know what it is they're seeing, but something will stand out, and by that an opening is created for them to be opened to Christ, sometimes many years later. Nothing done for others will go unused by God--sometime, someplace, He will raise it up and use it for good.

v. 8-- We are all one Body. We will see eye-to-eye in the Spirit. We have to remember that, and keep our eyes on things of the Spirit, and lift up one voice to praise the Lord, and draw others to Christ.

v. 9-- We can be truly joyful, for once we were waste place, but now we are with God, growing in His personal garden.

v. 10-- God has made it possible for everyone to be saved!!

v. 11-- We have to go out and tell the people this good news (v. 10). We are not only vessel bearers of the Lord, but we are vessels containing the Lord. Therefore, we should keep ourselves clean, and keep our minds stayed on Him.

v. 12-- We don't have to run, nor go in fear, for the Lord is with us and will gather the people up. We will wait on the Lord, and He will tell us where to go and what to say.

v. 13-- He is speaking of Jesus, who succeeded in walking the earth with no sin.

v. 14-- He is saying here that As many were "astonished", which means "destroyed" or "devastate" by Satan ("thee")--Jesus took on all that destruction and devastation, which is why He was "marred more than any man".

v. 15-- Jesus sprinkled many nations and people with His blood, as He performed the sacrificial ceremony. (See note, pages 55 and 56). Anything sprinkled with the blood of the sacrificial lamb is purified. We have been purified and made alive, and we see "that which had not been told" or that which only God can show us through our spirits.
