

Isaiah  
Chapter 54

v. 11-12-- We are rich in the Lord--Rich in all the things of Him --all that He has He freely gave to us through Christ. This includes the inward riches of the Soul and Spirit, and the prosperity of the life we live on earth. As long as we live to give, He will give us enough to give.

v. 13-- Our children are "taught of the Lord"--taught in the Spirit by the Holy Spirit.

v, 14-15-- In righteousness--by our rights through Jesus Christ, we will be fearless and victorious in all things.

v. 16-17-- Satan will always be making new weapons against us, but he can't make the weapon that's strong enough to defeat God's people who carry the righteousness of Christ.

Chapter 55

v. 1-- Come to Jesus--If you thirst, get the Living water--we have nothing to offer Him that's worth anything, but He wants us to give what we are--Buy it with our sins and failures.

v. 2-- We spend our time, money, and labors on the pleasures of this world. Jesus is asking us to fatten up our souls on the beautiful things He offers.

v. 3-- He's asking us to listen to Him--pay attention to Him, and He will give us all the mercies He promised the patriarchs. (See Deut. 5:2 & 3)

v. 4-5-- He has given Jesus to be our witness, leader and commander. Nations that didn't know Jesus are coming to Him because of God's plan of Salvation.

v. 6-- God's asking us to seek Him now while the offer of Salvation is still on.

v. 7-- No matter how much we've sinned, God will forgive us. "for He will abundantly pardon."

v. 8-9-- This well-known verse reminds us of our weakness and God's immensity, and likewise, of the immensity of His love for us. Our minds simply cannot comprehend that kind of Love, it must be revealed to our spirits, because they alone can comprehend it, and portray it to our minds in the ways it can grasp it.
